What is Section 504?

Section 504 of Rehabilitation Act of 1973

Prohibits Discrimination Based on Disability


Civil Rights Law

Need of students with disabilities must be met as adequately as the needs of non-disabled students are met.




Section 504 vs. IDEA

- Section 504 provides supports and accommodations
- IEP provides supports, accommodations, and services
- 504s are a function of general education



Who and What are Covered by Section 504 in Schools?



Definitions

Individual with a Disability

• Person who has a mental or physical impairment – including disability, long-term illness, or various other disorders

Substantially Limits

• Measured against non-disabled peers and without the benefit of mitigating measures.

Major Life Activity

• Including self-care, manual tasks, walking, seeing, speaking, sitting, thinking, learning, breathing, concentrating, learning, interacting with others, and working.

- Parent, teacher, or counselor may request a 504 evaluation
- Student Success Team may include teacher, counselor, principal or assistant principal, nurse, parent
- Reviews grades, parent observations, doctor's reports, outside testing reports, etc.

Evaluation Process & Implementation

Team Gathers Data

 Medical reports, parent/family interviews, school records, school observations, teacher reports, academic assessments, formal tools not required

Team Meets

School administrator, parents,/guardians, and perhaps others review data

Eligibility Determined

• Eligibility Summary Form

Evaluation Process & Implementation

Plan Implemented

• Reviewed with teacher(s)

Yearly Review

School administrator, parents,/guardians, and perhaps others review data

Three-Year Re-Evaluation

Accommodations must be RELATED TO THE DISABILITY and designed to provide EQUAL ACCESS
