# What is English Language Development (ELD)?

### **ELD Pilot Process**

- A group of pilot teachers and Multilingual Learner Department staff met for an orientation at the Ventura County Office of Education to learn about the different curriculum options.
- National Geographic and Vista Learning programs were selected and piloted for at least six weeks.
- Both programs were evaluated and a final decision was made.



### **Rationale for Selection**

- Picture vocabulary, graphic organizers, and collaborative activities






