### **Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELO-P)**

### What is it?

The Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELO-P) provides funding for afterschool and summer school enrichment programs for transitional kindergarten through sixth grade.

### When is it offered?

"Expanded learning" means before school, after school, summer, or intersession learning programs that focus on developing the academic, social, emotional, and physical needs and interests of pupils through hands-on, engaging learning experiences.

### **Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELO-P) Specifications**

#### **Hours of Program Components of the Day** No less than 9 hours of Can be provided before and/or after school program, includes school day **Locations of Program Days of Program** Can be provided on 1 or All school days + 30 multiple school sites within intersession days the district

## ELO-P Funding Guidelines

- Need to offer acess to 100% unduplicated students (EL, Foster, & SED)
- Required to serve at least 50% of unduplicated students in the 2022-23 year
- Once registered and provided access to ELOP program, the student is considered enrolled for the entire school year.

## **ELO-P Program Elements**

- 1. Educational and literacy element in which tutoring or homework assistance is provided in one or more of the following ways:
  - Language arts
  - Math
  - History/social science
  - Computer training
  - Science
- 2. Educational Enrichment
  - Fine Arts
  - Career Technical Education
  - Recreation, Physical Fitness, and Prevention Activities
- 3. Encouraged to collaborate with community based organizations
