PARENT/GUARDIAN STATEMENT

Required for all students:

The courts handle custody disputes. Schools have no legal jurisdiction to refuse a parent access to their student or their student's school record without a court order explicitly limiting the parent's access. Parents/guardians must provide custody, restraining, and/or other court orders to the school. The order must be stamped, dated, and signed by a judge. When such orders are received, appropriate school staff will be notified, and school staff will update the student's records. Should any such situation disrupt the school, staff will contact law enforcement.

WE ASK PARENTS TO MAKE EVERY ATTEMPT TO MINIMIZE CONFLICT AND NOT TO INVOLVE SCHOOL SITES IN CUSTODY MATTERS.
