



CONEJO VALLEY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT CHROMEBOOK ACCIDENTAL DAMAGE PROTECTION PROGRAM 2025-26

Conejo Valley Unified School District (CVUSD) is pleased to provide all students with a Chromebook through the District's 1:1 Program. While at no cost to families, proper use and care of the Chromebook is the responsibility of the student and their parent/guardian.

To support this program, CVUSD is offering **Chromebook Accidental Damage Protection** (ADP) program for parents to eliminate the concern and costs of repairing or replacing damaged, or stolen Chromebooks.

The District recommends parents/guardians purchase this **\$25 device accidental damage protection** from CVUSD. This fee covers potential incidents like cracked screens, missing keyboard keys, damaged plastics, liquid spills, and theft. Funds from this program will be used to repair damaged devices or replace the devices covered under the program.

Without accidental damage protection, typical repair costs for things like a broken screen or keyboard can range from \$100 - \$200. For excessive damage, Chromebooks have a replacement cost of \$400 for the current model. Our goal is to ease parent concerns over damage to devices while in their child's care and continue to support a sustainable take-home program for our schools.

The ADP program covers one replacement of a district-issued student device due to accidental damage, loss, or theft. Families may purchase multiple policies per student, with claims deducted from the student's purchased policies.

Purchasing Accidental Damage Protection is optional, but highly recommended. The enrollment window to purchase Accidental Damage Protection opens on August 1, 2025, and **will close on November 30, 2025**. Accidental Damage Protection purchases are non-refundable and expire on July 31, 2026.

Without Accidental Damage Protection, the student's legal parent/guardian is responsible for all costs associated with the repair or replacement of the device due to accidental damage, or theft. The student's legal parent/guardian agrees to reimburse the District for the cost of the students Chromebook within 30 days of reporting damage, theft, or any other loss.
