**WHEREAS,** it is necessary to eliminate and/or reduce certain classified positions and services, as specified below, being provided to the Conejo Valley Unified School District, in order to maintain a balanced budget, and to secure the fiscal integrity of the district; and

**WHEREAS**, the Superintendent is directed to give notice of layoff to the affected classified employees pursuant to the requirement of the law; and

**WHEREAS**, said layoff shall become effective no earlier than June 30, 2025, unless the position is or becomes vacant before said date, at which point the elimination or reduction in service shall be immediate; and

**WHEREAS,** employees laid off pursuant to this resolution shall be eligible for reemployment pursuant to Education Code § 45298.

**NOW, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Governing Board of the Conejo Valley Unified School District hereby determines that the following classified positions will be eliminated/reduced for lack of funds and/or lack of work.
