<u>DISCUSSION SESSION: CALIFORNIA SCHOOL BOARD ASSOCIATION (CSBA) ANNUAL CONFERENCE DEBRIEF</u>

Board President Pat Phelps called the Discussion Session to order at 4:05 p.m. Board Members and Executive Staff discussed sessions they found most informative and interesting at the CSBA Conference they attended in December, such as Lobbying 101, High School Sports Programs, Reinventing School Counseling in the 21st Century, Summer Learning opportunities, Freedom of the Press and School Publications, Summer Enrichment Programs and Family Resource Center, Multi-Year Budget, Negotiations, Common Core Learning with EL at the Center, Looking for Talent in Underrepresented Students. The Board and staff will continue to discuss and explore some of the programs that they determine would improve student learning.

REGULAR SESSION

OPENING PROVISIONS

Call to Order and Roll Call: President Phelps called the meeting to order at 6:17 p.m. Present were Board members John Andersen, Peggy Buckles, Dr. Betsy Connolly, Mike Dunn and Pat Phelps. Administration: Dr. Ann Bonitatibus, Superintendent; Robert Iezza, Deputy Superintendent, Instructional Services; Dr. Jon Sand, Assistant Superintendent, Business Services; Mark McLaughlin, Assistant Superintendent, Personnel Services; Jeanne Valentine, Director, Elementary Education, James Garza, Director, Secondary Education, Jerome Staszewski,

Director Technology Services, and David Fateh, Director, Planning & Construction. Mrs. Phelps welcomed everyone to the meeting and read the procedural announcements.

Approval of the Agenda

Mrs. Buckles moved to approve the agenda with the following correction: Under V. Action Items – Consent, Item B.1. Change the Certificated Employee numbers to #0062 - #0066, seconded by Dr. Connolly. Motion carried 5-0.

Presentations

Lori Wall, Principal, Ladera Elementary School, presented information about her school along with Julie Nerland, First Grade Teacher at Ladera. The focus was on LCAP Goal 2: Maximize Student Potential Through Effective Intervention. Mrs. Wall discussed a program that Ladera has been using called Target Time, which ensures that all students have core ELA instruction one hour a day, four days a week. Students who have high academic skills are also targeted for enrichment activities. The program includes a lot of collaboration among teachers. Mrs. Wall invited the Board and staff to come for a visit to watch the program in action.

Measure I Independent Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee Annual Report 2014-2015, Marshall Denninger, Chairperson. Dr. Jon Sand introduced the Measure I Oversight Committee and thanked them for their efforts and commitment. Mr. Denninger also thanked support staff. Measure I Midyear Update 2015-2016. Dr. Jon Sand, David Fateh, and Jerome Staszewski provided a report to the Board of projects for the first six months of the school year. Board members had questions and commendations for the staff and project planning. Comments from the Public

One public speaker thanked the District for planning the use of Measure I funds to reach every student. The speaker also thanked the Board for honoring counselors during National School Counseling Week, and encouraged the Board to hire more counselors for the students.

Comments from the Superintendent

Dr. Bonitatibus congratulated Ana Alvarez, Parent Outreach Coordinator, for being named in *The Acorn's* Top 10 People of 2015. She was recognized as a community leader making an impact through her believe that doors are opened through education. She thanked Sepideh Yeoh, founder of Gaining Insight for Transition (GIFT), for the opportunity to speak at her networking group for women who have undergone transition. This was part of GIFT's speaker series on Women Who Inspire. Dr. Bonitatibus's favorite learner moment was at Leadership Conejo, a leadership development group affiliated with the Greater Conejo Valley Chamber of Commerce. The theme of the event was Talent Spotting. Here, business leaders were able to see Newbury Park High School culinary arts students prepare and serve a catered breakfast. From there, students from Westlake Elementary School wowed the audience with a video and demonstration about their makerspace. Finally, there were roundtables with students from each high school who spoke to the business leaders about the skills they are learning. It was a pleasure showcasing CVUSD student talent.

Comments from Individual Board Members

Mrs. Buckles was pleased to report about the Greater Conejo Valley Chamber of Commerce Leadership Education Day that was held at Newbury Park High School. The morning started with breakfast planned, prepared and served by the Culinary Class at Newbury Park High School, then featured Westlake Hills Elementary students highlighting the Makerspace Program at their school, and ended with a tour of the School-to-Career classes at the school. Mrs. Buckles commended the presentation by the Open Classroom Leadership Magnet at the DAC meeting. She referenced an email from parent Rocky Capobianco who praised Century Academy and thanked him for his message.

Mr. Andersen also thanked Mr. Capobianco for his correspondence regarding Century Academy's hybrid learning model and mentioned his "wish list" or the program. He shared two articles with the board: from Investors Business Daily, Why Asian-American Kids Succeed – Tough Parents, and one from Yahoo Finance, The Most Endangered Jobs of 2016.

Dr. Connolly stated that although there are no categorical funds set aside for GATE, the District has an outstanding set of programs that serve academically gifted students, e.g., Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, and others.

Mrs. Phelps also mentioned "The Leader in Me" program through the Open Classroom Leadership Magnet at Conejo Elementary School that was highlighted at the DAC meeting.
