February 24, 2004 <u>MINUTES</u>

The Conejo Valley Unified School District Board of Education met in Regular Session on February 24, 2004, at the District Office Board Room, 1400 East Janss Road, Thousand Oaks, California.

CALL TO ORDER

Dr. Robert Fraisse, Superintendent, Richard Simpson, Assistant Superintendent, Instructional Services, Jody Dunlap, Assistant Superintendent, Personnel Services, and Dr. Jeffrey Baarstad, Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, were in attendance. Martha Mutz, Director, Curriculum/Media Services and Dr. Michael Vollmert, Associate Director, Research, Evaluation and Assessment, were also present.
