# **OPENING PROVISIONS**

Call to Order and Roll Call: Dr. Connolly called the meeting to order at 6:09 p.m. Present were Board members Peggy Buckles, Dr. Betsy Connolly, Mike Dunn and Dr. Timothy Stephens. Pat Phelps, Board Member, was absent. Administration: Dr. Jeffrey Baarstad, Superintendent, Janet Cosaro, Deputy Superintendent, and Linda Bekeny, Assistant Superintendent, Business Services. Also present were Robert Iezza, Director, Elementary Education, Dr. Jeff Davis, Director, Secondary Education and Carol Boyan-Held, Director, Curriculum.

Dr. Connolly read the procedural announcements and welcomed everyone to the meeting.

#### Approval of the Agenda

# **Comments from the Superintendent**

Dr. Baarstad 1) thanked Dr. Antonio Castro, Principal, Los Cerritos Middle School, Dr. Jon Sand, Principal, Sycamore Canyon School, counselors Kathleen Murvin and Dawn Paulson, and teachers Karen Greenberg and Jill Magnante, for their excellent presentation regarding middle school students and education at the Annual California State PTA Convention, 2) commended the students, music directors, and all those involved with the tremendous All-District Music Festivals that have been running for the past couple of weeks at the Kavli Theater, 3) congratulated the Valedictorians and their families for all the hard work that goes into such an outstanding achievement, and 4) thanked the Classified Employees who were honored for their valuable and unique contributions throughout the District. Dr. Baarstad announced the Annual CSEA Family Picnic scheduled for Saturday, May 19, at Acorn Acres Park.

One public speaker discussed the RDA successor meeting at the City of Thousand Oaks and the letter from the state auditors in Sacramento denying the City's request.

#### **Comments from Individual Board Members**

Mrs. Buckles also thanked Drs. Castro and Sand and staff for their presentation at the State PTA Convention. Mr. Dunn questioned Dr. Baarstad about some of the comments regarding the public speaker's report from the RDA successor meeting. Dr. Stephens and Dr. Connolly commented on the Employee Service Awards and Retirement program the previous week, and commended Tim Carpenter and staff for the success of the program.

## <u>ACTION ITEMS – GENERAL</u>

## **Board of Education and Superintendent**

## A. Resolution #11/12-27: Ordering a Governing Board Member Election

Mrs. Buckles moved to <u>adopt Resolution #11/12-27 Ordering a Governing Board Member Election</u>, seconded by Dr. Stephens. Motion carried 4-0.

## B. Approval of BP 7132 – Placement of Wireless Communication Towers

Mrs. Buckles moved to approve Board Policy 7132 – Placement of Wireless Communication Towers, as submitted, seconded by Mr. Dunn. There was one public speaker who asked the Board to consider stronger language in the policy that would specifically address the issue of urging the City of Thousand Oaks to consider distance when planning to install cell towers. Mrs. Buckles asked to amend the motion that the Board of Education urges local public agencies to consider the distance of proposed cell towers from schools sites when evaluating applications for new cell towers. Mr. Dunn seconded the amendment. Dr. Connolly stated her concern about the Board of Education urging the City Council/Planning Commission to consider distance from school sites. She stated that she would not want to put the City in a position of possible litigation or to place the City and District in conflict. Dr. Baarstad stated that his concern is interference in the City's business, however, he would support the Board's decision either way. Dr. Connolly stated that the current policy language to request the City to inform the District about proposed cell tower installations, and the District subsequently informing parents, should provide an added layer of protection.

The Board voted on the amendment: amend the motion that the Board of Education urges local public agencies to consider the distance of proposed cell towers from schools sites when evaluating applications for new cell towers. Motion tied 2-2 (Stephens, Buckles-aye, Connolly, Dunn-nay). Without a majority vote, the motion did not pass.

The Board voted on the original motion: <u>approve Board Policy 7132 – Placement of Wireless Communication</u> Towers, as submitted. Motion carried 4-0.

#### **Personnel Services**

C. Resolution #11/12-24: Classified School Employee Week – May 20-26, 2012

Mr. Dunn moved to <u>adopt the attached proclamation declaring May 20-26, 2012, as "Classified Employee Week,"</u> seconded by Mrs. Buckles. Dr. Connolly commended classified staff and thanked them for their support. Motion carried 4-0.

**D.** Resolution #11/12-25: Layoff/Reduction of Classified Positions

Mrs. Buckles moved to approve Resolution #11/12-25: Layoff/Reduction of Classified Positions as submitted, seconded by Dr. Stephens. Mrs. Bekeny stated that the cuts in the Neighborhood for Learning (NfL) staffing were due to State cuts in the First 5-tobacco money and the State's preschool funding. Motion carried 4-0.

- E. Establishment of Classified Positions
  - Dr. Stephens <u>moved to approve the establishment of classified assignments as specified</u>, seconded by Mrs. Buckles. Motion carried 4-0.
- **F.** PUBLIC HEARING: Initial Response to the 2011-2012 Proposal for Successor Collective Bargaining Negotiations Submitted by the United Association of Conejo Teachers (UACT) Dr. Connolly opened the Public Hearing at 7:20 p.m. There were no public speakers to the issue. Dr. Connolly closed the Public Hearing at 7:22 p.m.
