## **CALL TO ORDER – CLOSED SESSION**

#### **REGULAR SESSION**

### **OPENING PROVISIONS**

Call to Order and Roll Call: President Stephens called the meeting to order at 6:10 p.m. Present were Board members Peggy Buckles, Dr. Betsy Connolly, Mike Dunn, Pat Phelps and Dr. Timothy Stephens. Administration: Dr. Jeffrey Baarstad, Superintendent, Robert Iezza, Assistant Superintendent, Instructional Services, Linda Bekeny, Assistant Superintendent, Business Services, and Mark McLaughlin, Assistant Superintendent, Personnel Services.

Dr. Jeff Davis, Director, Secondary Education, Carol Boyan-Held, Director, Elementary Education and Dr. Jon Sand, Director, Curriculum and Assessment, were also present.

Dr. Stephens read the procedural announcements and welcomed everyone to the meeting.

### Approval of the Agenda

Mrs. Phelps moved to <u>approve the agenda with the following change: on the Agenda, V. Information Items, D. Approval of Amendments to Board Policy 5145.3, change page number from 86 to 98, seconded by Mr. Dunn. Motion carried 5-0.</u>

#### Presentation: Outdoor School, Dr. Jeff Davis, Director, Secondary Education

Dr. Davis introduced Cheryl Moncourtois, the new Outdoor School Coordinator for 2013-2014. Dr. Davis also presented information about alternative outdoor education programs and costs for future years. Dr. Connolly reminded Dr. Davis that the Board promised parents two conditions would apply at outdoor school, regardless of where it would be: 1) that all cabins would be fully screened and 2) carbon monoxide monitors would be present in every cabin. The Board and staff discussed the need for a two-year commitment to a District-operated program with the new coordinator in order to have a fair assessment to compare with programs operated by outside entities.

#### **Comments from the Superintendent**

Dr. Baarstad was happy to announce the FBI's release of the Nation's Safest Cities, with Thousand Oaks being #1 in California, and #4 nation-wide! He complimented Thousand Oaks Police Department for their proactive, school and community based policing programs. He announced that Sunday, October 20, is the Rotary Street Fair and that the District will have two booths – one for general information and one for the Conejo Schools Foundation and Conejo Council PTA. He also assured Dr. Connolly and the Board that their Board Planning Calendar would be available to review soon.

#### **Comments from the Public**

There were no public speakers.

#### **Comments from Individual Board Members**

Dr. Connolly discussed the Sounds of the Conejo event held at Thousand Oaks High School. She emphasized that the event was not meant as a competition, but an opportunity for schools to showcase their new field shows and then take the field together. Dr. Stephens also commented on the Sounds of the Conejo event. He also attended a program sponsored by Corwin Press that brought Dr. John Hattie, a world-renown educational researcher who has spent the last 20 years studying student achievement. Dr. Hattie believes that two main factors are necessary to increase student achievement: staff development and teacher expertise in the classroom. The program was held at the Westlake Hyatt and was attended by educators from across the nation. Dr. Stephens thanked Mike Soules, President of Corwin Press and also President of the Conejo Schools Foundation, for the opportunity to hear Dr. Hattie.
