Trustee Capobianco made the motion to approve, seconded by Trustee Goldberg. Dr. Hayek provided information on the performance and financial audit portions of this report. Dr. Hayek responded to questions from Board members regarding key takeaways from this combined review process with the Bond Oversight Committee and auditors. **Motion carried:** 5-0, with a preferential "yes" vote from Student Trustee Xu.
