NPHS Course Selection Guidelines

Schedule changes will **not** be made to accommodate teacher requests, period requests, extracurricular or athletic activities.

A **required schedule change** will be made for a student who failed a course or who completed a pre-approved summer school course.

A **requested schedule change** will be made only if it improves the integrity of your schedule for graduation or college entrance requirements **AND** if there is space available. Schedule change requests can be addressed in August during Schedule Pick-Up Day.

Athletics

If you play a NPHS team sport, you will earn 5 credits each season toward your 20-credit PE requirement.
