Course Description:

This course is offered for the advanced student interested in learning lifelong skills in the area of fine wood working and furniture building. Thereafter the student will be able to work on a project of their choice after completion of a full set of plans and approval from the instructor. Emphasis will be on safety and quality of workmanship. This class is about the world of work and each student will need to be in attendance and participate fully in all activities.
