Course Description:

Throughout this course, students will focus on textual analysis of various genres of text such as fiction, nonfiction, poetry, and short stories from mostly American authors. Students will utilize figurative language within their analysis, further build their vocabulary and grammar abilities, and enhance research skills in preparation for and completion of a Capstone assessment. This course is best suited to students with the ability to remain largely self-directed throughout the year while completing assignments in a timely fashion that are mostly delivered online via a learning management system. There are limited in-person class meetings, so students are expected to seek help as needed by visiting their instructor during office hours, seventh period, and/or via email communication on a regular basis. Furthermore, students must be willing to dedicate roughly an hour a day to the class, mainly independently, to meet the requirements of a daily class meeting and homework. This course is designed to meet the academic English requirements necessary for students to be successful in post-high school educational programs.

Grading:

Grades are determined mainly by small summative assessments (quizzes) and larger unit exams. Students will be graded on grammar, writing mechanics, punctuation, spelling, reading comprehension, and analytical skills throughout the course.

Syllabus:

The syllabus will be provided by the instructor at the start of the school year.
