

COURSE TITLE: Mandarin Chinese 3

Course Description:

The course continues to focus on building oral and written proficiency on daily topics with student-centered activities. Students enlarge their inventory of words and phrases while also developing a deeper understanding of the essential features of Chinese grammar. Longer texts and dialogues are introduced and much of the class time is devoted to oral proficiency development on concrete topics that are related to high school student lives and their perspectives. Texts, supplementary readings, audio/ video materials, and online sources are used to provide a rich and complete learning experience. The course will also examine the Chinese culture within an international context, helping students broaden their worldview by comparing Chinese cultural products, practices and perspectives with those of their own country.
