In-person Instruction Grant (ELOG)	\$5,384,234.00	8/31/22
Homeless Allocation (ELOG)	\$152,000.00	8/31/22
Paraprofessional Allocation (ELOG)	\$1,134,091.00	8/31/22
Total	\$16,877,145.00	

Reminder: ELOG is one layer of multiple-layers of stimulus funding (ESSER I, ESSER II, potentially ESSER III) and we also have LCAP

Stakeholder Engagement and Input

Engagement:

- 26 School Site Council meetings
- 1200 responses to community-wide survey
- 2 Reopen and Redesign meetings
- Communication with labor partners

Most Common Input Themes:

- Provide mental health services to students
- Address learning loss through targeted supports and interventions
- Increase staffing to allow for smaller class sizes and individualized instruction
- Provide instruction and enrichment during the summer
