Vaccination Clinic

The District has arranged with Ventura County to provide a mobile vaccination clinic for students ages 5-18 at the District Educational Center, 1400 N. Janss Road, Thousand Oaks.

- The clinic will take place on December 11th from 1-4PM
- Information about the clinic will be distributed to parents approximately two weeks before the clinic.
- Information and on-site assistance will be provided in Spanish
- Additional clinics will be set up based on demand



Vaccination

How will I know the difference between my child having COVID-19 symptoms and a reaction to the vaccination?

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) provided this guidance:

- **Timing:** Reactions to the vaccination normally occur <u>within 3 days</u> of the vaccination
- **Type of Symptoms:** Side effects from the vaccine include: Pain, redness, or swelling where you get your shot, Tiredness, Headache, Muscle pain, Chills, Fever, Nausea, BUT side effects do not include COVID-19 symptoms of Coughing, Runny Nose, Sore Throat, Difficulty in breathing, or Loss of Taste or Smell
- **Testing:** The vaccine will not result in a positive COVID-19 test. So, if a parent wants to be certain, they can have their child tested.
