
COVID-19 Safety Plan Update September 2021



Key Safety Layers: Making Schools the Safest Places in the Community



Changes in the Prevention Strategy

OLD

- Hand Hygiene
- Routine Cleaning & Disinfection
- Ventilation
- Physical Distance
- Stable Groups
- Limited Sharing of Equipment
- Sereening Staff & Students of Symptoms
- Handling of Sick Persons & Close Contacts
- Use of Face Covering & other PPE

NEW

- <u>Vaccination</u>
- Masks
- Ventilation
- Self-Screening Staff & Students of Symptoms

- Routine Testing for COVID-19

Vaccination

- Not Mandatory for staff or students
- By October 15th the district is required to verify school workers who are not vaccinated and require unvaccinated workers to be tested for COVID-19 once a week.
- "Workers" include school volunteers and contract workers who work with students.
- Workers who are not verified as fully vaccinated will be considered unvaccinated.
- Asymptomatic persons who are fully vaccinated do not need to quarantine after close contact with a positive case



Masks

- Masks are optional **outdoors** for all in Pre K-Post Secondary School settings.
- Masks required **indoors** for all students and adults.
- Exceptions: eating, in a room or vehicle alone
- Persons exempted from wearing a face covering due to a medical condition, must wear a non-restrictive alternative, such as a face shield with a drape on the bottom edge, as long as their condition permits it.
- A note from a medical provider is required for medical an exemption.



Masks – What is Acceptable?




Ventilation

- Maximize the infusion of outdoor air by maximizing the HVAC fresh air intake and keeping windows and doors open as practical.
- Maintain MERV-13 filtration on HVAC systems where feasible.
- Use portable HEPA air filtration units in rooms with higher potential for aerosol spread and rooms with no ventilation or poorly functioning ventilation systems.



STUDENT/STAFF MEMBER EXPERIENCING COVID-19 SYMPTOMS



INDIVIDUAL SEEKS MEDICAL GUIDANCE AND/OR COVID-19 TESTING

SCENARIO 1: Negative COVID-19 Test Results

Student/staff member may return to school/work after 24 hours of no fever (without use of fever reducing medicine) and other symptoms have improved.

SCENARIO 2: Positive COVID-19 Test Results

Student/staff member must isolate for 10 days, and inform school site of positive test results.


Individuals testing positive may return to school after 10 days, as long as they have no new symptoms AND are fever free for more than 24 hours without fever reducing medications.

SCENARIO 3: No Test

Student/staff can return to school/work if they provide a note from doctor confirming another underlying medical condition OR a note from doctor confirming another non-COVID-19 diagnosis and they are fever free and symptoms have improved OR 10 days have passed since symptom onset.

ESCENARIO 1: Resultado negativo de la prueba COVID-19

El estudiante / personal puede regresar a la escuela / trabajo después de 24 horas sin fiebre (sin el uso de medicamentos para reducir la fiebre) y otros síntomas han mejorado.

ESCENARIO 2: Resultados positivos de la prueba COVID-19

El estudiante / personal debe aislar por 10 días e informar a la escuela sobre los resultados positivos de la prueba.

Las personas que den positivo pueden regresar a la escuela después de 10 días, siempre y cuando no tengan sintomas nuevos y no tengan fiebre durante más de 24 horas sin medicamentos para reducir la fiebre.

ESCENARIO 3: No examen

El estudiante / personal puede regresar a la escuela / trabajo si proporciona una nota del médico que confirme una condición de salud precaria o una nota del médico que confirme otro diagnóstico que no sea COVID-19 y no tenga fiebre y los síntomas hayan mejorado O 10 han pasado días desde la aparición de los síntomas.

Close Contact* - No Symptoms Unvaccinated, Unmasked

· Quarantine at home.



 Quarantine ends after 10 Days from the last date of exposure to the person testing positive.

Close Contact* - No Symptoms

Vaccinated, Masked/Unmasked

No quarantine is necessary for vaccinated students, either masked or unmasked. as long as they have no symptoms of COVID-19, and proof of vaccination is provided.





If a Close Contact* has symptoms: Immediately, remove from school, isolate at home.

Close contacts who develop symptoms of COVID-19 must:

- 1. Get tested for COVID-19
- 2. If positive they must isolate for 10 days from the start of symptoms or the date of the positive test if no symptoms.
- 3. If negative test they should continue quarantine and return only if fever free and symptoms have improved.

Close Contact* - No Symptoms Unvaccinated, Masked SCHOOL SETTINGS ONLY

(MODIFIED QUARANTINE)

Both the exposed student and the student with COVID-19 were wearing a face mask during the whole time of close contact.

- Continues to attend school.
- Does not participate in extra-curricular activities in school or community setting.
- In general, it is recommended to test immediately after being exposed to someone with COVID-19. Subsequent testing should occur at least 3 days apart.

*Close Contact is defined as within 6 feet for 15 cumulative minutes within a 24-hour period of someone with a confirmed case of COVID-19.

**The information in this chart is determined by guidance from the California Department of Public Health and Ventura County Public Health.

Students testing positive may return to school after 10 days of isolation, as long as they have no new symptoms AND are fever free for more than 24 hours without fever reducing medications.

Contacto cercano * - Sin síntomas No vacunado, sin cubrebocas

Cuarentena en casa.



 La cuarentena termina después de 10 días a partir de la última fecha de exposición a la persona que da prueba positiva.

Contacto cercano * - Sin síntomas cubrebocas/sin cubrebocas

No es necesaria la cuarentena para los estudiantes vacunados, ya sea con o sin cubrebocas siempre y cuando no presenten síntomas de COVID-19 y prueba de

vacunación es previsto.





Si un contacto cercano * tiene síntomas:

inmediatamente retírelo de la escuela, aíslelo en casa.

Los contactos cercanos que desarrollen síntomas de COVID-19 deben:

- 1. Hacerse la prueba de COVID-19
- Si es positivo, se debe aislar durante 10 días desde el inicio de los síntomas o desde la fecha de la prueba positiva si no hay síntomas.
- 3. Si la prueba es negativa, deben continuar con la cuarentena y regresar solo si no tienen fiebre y los síntomas han mejorado.

RESULTADOS POSITIVOS DE LA PRUEBA COVID-19

Aislamiento completo en el hogar durante 10 días independientemente del estado de vacunación y el uso de cubreboca

Contacto cercano * - Sin síntomas
 No vacunado, cubrebocas
 EN ESPACIO ESCOLAR SOLAMENTE
 (CUARENTENA MODIFICADA)

** Tanto el estudiante expuesto como el estudiante con COVID-19 usaron un cubrebocas durante todo el tiempo de contacto cercano.

- Continúa asistiendo a la escuela.
- No participa en actividades extracurriculares en la escuela o en la comunidad.
- En general, se recomienda probar inmediatamente después de haber estado expuesto a alguien con COVID-19. Las pruebas posteriores deben realizarse con al menos 3 días de diferencia.



*El contacto cercano se define como dentro de 6 pies durante 15 minutos acumulativos dentro de un período de 24 horas de alguien con un caso confirmado de COVID-19.

COVID-19 Symptoms for Self-Check

- Dolor de garganta
- Congestión
- Fiebre (99.5 o más)
- Nariz congestionada
- Fatiga extrema
- Tos
- Escalofríos
- Dolor de cabeza

- Falta de aire
- Nausea
- Dolores musculares y corporales
- Respiración difícil
- Vómitos
- Pérdida del olfato o el gusto
- Diarrea
