Key Developments - District Wide

- Developed <u>CVUSD CTE Website</u> and <u>CVUSD Secondary</u>
 <u>Course Catalog</u> to advertise Pathways
- Secured grant funds to provide industry-standard equipment and materials for students and innovative professional development for teachers
- Hired three new counselors to focus on CTE pathway enrollment and increasing completion of the A-G college entrance requirements
- Developing additional CTE Career pathways at the high schools and one of the middle schools



Key Developments

- **Expanded outreach and awareness** to increase the number of targeted **student populations** completing CTE pathways
- Expanding dual enrollment (DE) course offerings in partnership with our Community Colleges - recently applied for DE Access Pathways Grant









Conejo Valley HS Highlights

- CVHS offers two CTE pathways on campus: **Graphic Design** and **Introduction to Business**
- The CTE classes offered at CVHS allow students to develop career and technical skills transferable to the workplace and college level courses
- Students can take ROP classes off campus as well, as their schedules are flexible to accommodate taking transportation to Career Education Center classes in Camarillo
- Access to CS5 Adobe Suite and other top of the line software for graphic design and video production projects
- Students enrolled in our CTE courses have the opportunity to work with and visit outside local organizations, such as MANNA Food Bank and the Thousand Oaks Teen Center
- Variety of hands-on learning opportunities with state of the art tools, including a
