Educator Effectiveness Funds (2021-2026)

- **Purpose:** One-time funds of \$3,739,625 for CVUSD to support professional learning for certificated teachers, administrators, paraprofessional educators, and certificated staff. Funds may be expended during the 2021–22, 2022–23, 2023–24, 2024–25 and 2025–26 fiscal years.
- **Reporting:** An annual data and expenditure report will be due each year on or before September 30. A final data and expenditure report will be due on or before September 30, 2026.



Allowable Uses

- 1. Coaching and mentoring of staff in an instructional setting and beginning teacher or administrator induction.
- 2. Programs that lead to effective, standards-aligned instruction and improve instruction in literacy.
- 3. Practices and strategies that re-engage pupils and lead to accelerated learning.
- 4. Strategies to implement social-emotional learning, trauma-informed practices, suicide prevention, access to mental health services, and other approaches that improve pupil well-being.
- 5. Practices to create a positive school climate.
- 6. Strategies to improve inclusive practices.
- 7. Instruction and education to support implementing effective language acquisition programs for English Learners.
- 8. New professional learning networks for educators.
- 9. Instruction, education, and strategies to incorporate ethnic studies curricula pursuant to EC Section 51226.7
- 10. Instruction, education, and strategies for educators in early childhood education, or childhood development.



Next Steps

- Review prior stakeholder feedback from LCAP (Spring 2021) and ESSER III (Fall 2021)
- Analyze existing Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) goals to strengthen with additional professional learning
- Meet with all labor partners to receive input
- Local plan will be presented to the Board of Education for approval on December 14, 2021
