

2022-23 Camp Overview

Location:

• Camp Ramah, 45 miles away in Ojai, CA

Schedule:


- 6th Grade 4 days, 3 nights (Monday Thursday or Tuesday Friday)
- 8th Grade 2 ½ days, 2 nights (Monday Wednesday or Wednesday Friday)
- 17 sessions scheduled from late January through early May

Staff:

Coordinator, naturalists, nurses, cabin support,
HS student counselors, and 6th grade teacher visits

Curriculum:

- Students learn Earth Science in local habitat and participate in outdoor activities
- Building areas of self-awareness, social awareness, and relationships skills



2022-2023 Camp Overview


Student Fee:

- 6th grade \$250/student; \$199/day camp.
- 8th grade \$165/student; \$130/day camp.
- No student shall be denied participation due to a lack of funds.

Overall cost of camp: \$423,925.00

Upcoming Family Information Nights:

- Will hold for 6th and 8th grade families separately.

8th Grade Experience

2.5 days that include:

- Orientation Hike
- 2 evening programs (campfire & evening hike)
- 4 Trail Classes
- Emphasis on 6th-8th grade science curriculum:
 - Parts of a Plant
 - Plant/Animal Identification
 - Photosynthesis and Respiration
 - Waves and Echolocation in Bats
 - Refraction of Light at Sunset
 - Magnetism in Rocks
 - Newton's Laws in Astronomy



Supporting Access and Equity

- Outreach and financial assistance will be provided to families identified in need.
- An additional Family Information Night will be held for students in Specialized Programs.
- Students may choose to participate in camp during the day, but not stay overnight ("Day Camp").
- Medical/health services that are identified in a student's Health Plan are provided by full-time nurse staff.
- Parent/guardian pre-meeting with Outdoor School Coordinator to discuss student health needs and/or support.
- Modified activities are provided to students as needed.
- Paraprofessional support, as specified in a student's IEP, is provided during the day and evening.
- Naturalists and counselors provide visual supports for students as specified in a student's IEP.
- Meals have Vegetarian, Vegan, and Gluten-Free options available.



Camp Health & Safety Procedures

CVUSD and Camp Ramah have worked closely together to update the COVID-19 health and safety procedures for 6th & 8th Grade Outdoor School:

- Masks will be strongly recommended for any limited indoor educational activities;
- Camp Ramah will continue to provide MERV-13 filters for all facilities.
- Windows in cabin rooms will remain open pending weather conditions.
- Staff will promote handwashing throughout the day.
- Nurse on site 24 hours a day.
- High touch surfaces in restrooms and cabins will be cleaned once a day.
