Overall Satisfaction with the Conference

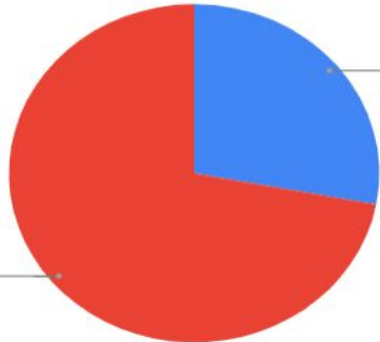

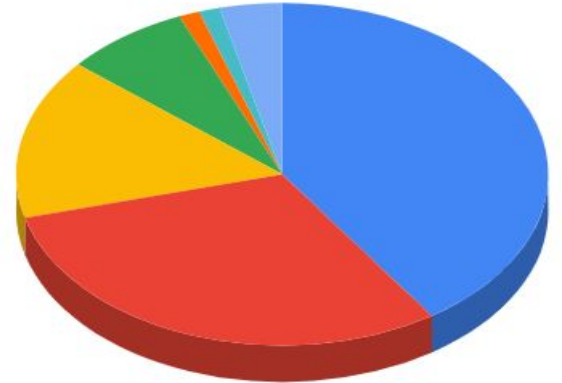
