- Project 2Inspire is a research-based program that focuses on providing parents with leadership and facilitation skills as well as content knowledge in areas that focus on effective communication, early childhood education, 21st century skills, college and career readiness, state standards, academic programs, etc.
- Cultivates our English Learner parents' capacity to foster the partnership between parents and the school system leading to significant gains in student achievement across the board.



Goals & Learning Outcomes for Project 2Inspire Participants

- Increases the leadership skills, knowledge development and educational commitment of parents to raise the academic achievements of their children.
- Increases the capacity of schools and districts to maintain a commitment to a high quality parent leadership program focused on student achievement.
- Develops the leadership skills of parents, as trainers of other parents, in schools.
- Strengthens partnerships between families, staff and community.
- Builds capacity of parents to actively engage in the LCAP process.
- Parents become positive change agents by motivating other parents to participate in school committees.



Structure of Project 2Inspire

- Title III federal funds support this program
- The Multilingual Learners and Equity Department oversees the program. The director is present at the trainings and is in constant communication with the Project 2Inspire staff.
- Recruitment efforts are initiated and continued by the school site staff throughout the program. Project 2Inspire personnel follow-up with parents to ensure they continue attending all of the required modules.
