# Environmental Subcommittee

- Proposal to reduce plastic waste on campus given to SDAC
- Connecting with environmental-based student groups on campus
- Educating students and recycling properly by creating signage increasing access to recycling
- Looking forward to finishing the plastic waste reduction proposal, then discussing food waste

# Educational Equity Subcommittee

- Outreach to affinity groups, helping emphasize out-of-school support options
- Joint meeting with Campus Culture and AADAC Representative Mrs. Nicole Updegraff
  - SDAC is an important tool to drive social change throughout the district
- Created templates for SDAC social media posts to familiarize students with SDAC
- Looking forward to rethinking SDAC mission statement to include clearly anti-discrimination language, furthering publicity for SDAC to encourage reporting and feedback, and fostering connections with affinity groups and campuses

# Financial Literacy Subcommittee

- Student survey sent out across CVUSD campuses
- Analyzed survey data to focus on what students felt was most important
- Coordinated with math teachers on incorporating financial literacy into their curriculum
- Found pre-existing curriculum from reliable sites (including the CA Department of Education)
- Goal shifted to making financial literacy curriculum more interdisciplinary and not just limited to math classes



# Mental Health Subcommittee Highlights

- Worked with publicity to create and put out forms regarding student mental health and gathering data to figure what areas of mental health resources need more growth
- Talked with peers who have used the wellness center to receive feedback and analyzed wellness center student usage data
- Future goals: follow up on success/areas of growth for wellness centers, work with publicity to work on a mental health feedback form that could potentially go out regularly

# Publicity Subcommittee

- Discussed new ways to capture student input for SDAC
- Developed a standard Student Input survey format
  - Incorporating subcommittee's questions into one survey
- Implementing SDAC student clubs on each school site to connect SDAC Reps with the Student body

# Campus Culture Subcommittee

- New subcommittee created at November meeting
- Discussing improvements for all-access bathrooms on campus
- Joint meeting with Ed. Eq. and AADAC Representative Mrs. Updegraff
- Looking forward to utilizing more survey data to focus on issues students find important
  - Better solutions for parking on-campus (transferable passes, etc)
  - Out of classroom learning opportunities to engage students in learning
  - Vaping and drug use, *not just in bathrooms*

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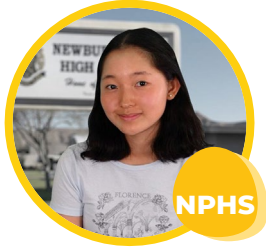

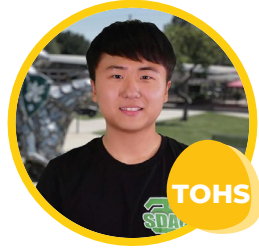
