History of School Choice in CVUSD and Creation of EARThS Magnet School

- Choice dates back nearly 30 years
- High movement at high school level
 - Competitive model
 - Signature programs
 - Visual/Performing Arts
 - Athletics
- Growing movement at middle school level due to space
- Limited to facility and staffing constraints at elementary

EARThS created as a:

- No boundary School of Choice
- STEM Magnet
- School uniforms
- Hands-on learning
- High parent involvement
- Created as a response to community request for STEM

Enrollment by CVUSD Cluster - 2019/2020

Current EARThS Enrollment = 543

448 Students (82.5%) Accepted from the NP Cluster

70 Students (12.9%) Accepted from the **TO** Cluster

16 Students (2.9%) Accepted from the Westlake Cluster

9 Students (1.7%) Accepted from Out of District

Recommended Changes to BP/AR

- Dates and Timelines have been updated
- Increasing Access to Students in the EARThS "AREA" is a priority
- Committee recommendations:
 - Use the former Manzanita Elementary Boundary to define "AREA"
 - Institute a multi-tiered lottery system to address the stated need

<u>Three-Tier Lottery – EARThS Kindergarten Only</u>

Tier 1 - Preschool Program - 10% set-aside for current enrollees of the CVUSD Preschool Program located on the EARThS campus

Tier 2 – All remaining pre-school and all in **"AREA"** kindergarten applicants will be considered for this placement with 15% of the available/remaining spaces allocated

Tier 3 – All remaining preschool, in **"AREA,"** and in-district kindergarten applicants for EARThS Magnet School will be considered for placement with all remaining seats allocated

<u>Three-Tier Lottery – EARThS Only</u>

Total Annual Kindergarten Seats at EARThS = 88
