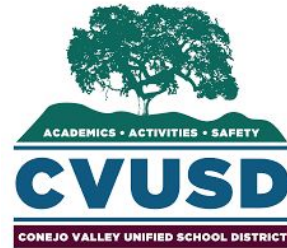

Summer Learning Camp (SLC)

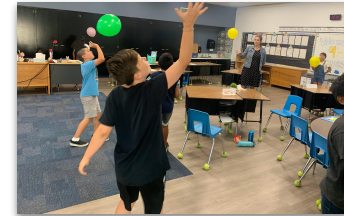
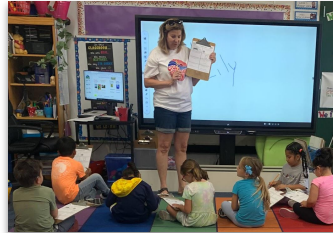
July 5 - July 28, 8:30-12:00

Students Served:

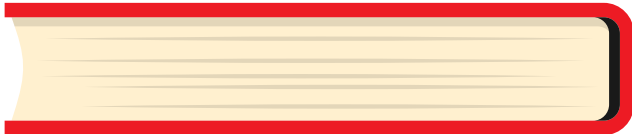
- Students who received D's or F's at Semester 1 or Quarter 3
- English Learners
- Students on an IEP
- Students seeking to accelerate in math pathway

Courses

- ELD, ELA and Math Intervention
- Enrichment (i.e. Drama, 3D Art, STEM, & World Cultures and Geography)
- Math Boost Camp

Enrollment Process:

1. Identified students received the Summer School Interest Form
2. Outreach is being conducted to complete the Master Agreement and Transportation Application



Expanded Learning Opportunities Program (ELO-P)

- Hosted at the Los Cerritos Middle School Boys & Girls Club Campus
- For rising 6th grade English Learners, Foster Youth and Low Income students
- Students have 2 options for participation:
 - Attend from 11:50 AM to 5:30 PM if participating in summer school
 - Attend from 8:30-5:30 if not participating in summer school
- Enrichment program
 - Sports and recreation
 - Social-emotional learning activities
 - STEM
 - Performing arts



High School

General Information:

- Grades 9-12, Hosted at WHS
- July 5th-28th
 - 8:30 AM -11:00 AM (Session 1)
 - 11:30 AM -2:00 PM (Session 2)
- Free lunch provided to all students
- Transportation available (must apply)

Students Served:

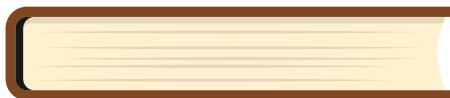
- Students who received D's or F's at Semester 1 or 2
- English Learners (acceleration)
- Students on an IEP (acceleration)
- Students who are Foster Youth/Homeless
- Students in AVID program

Courses

- **Credit Recovery** - Core Academic Subjects in English, Math, H/SS, Science, PE
- ELD, ELA and Math Intervention
- **Accelerated Courses:** PE, Health, World & US History

Extended School Year (ESY)

General Information:

- Preschool, hosted at Be Me (University Campus)
- Grades TK - 8, hosted at Aspen Elementary
- Grades 9 - Postsecondary, hosted at Westlake High School
- ESY runs from June 21 through July 21
 - July 3, July 4, and July 5 are non-school days
- Free breakfast and lunch is provided to all students
- Transportation is available (must apply)

Only students with IEPs are eligible to participate in ESY. ESY is for students with an IEP that will regress in skills without recoupment comparable to their peers and thus require an extension to their school year (20 days).

Early-Back Intervention

- Hosted at Acacia, Conejo and Walnut
- For TK-5 Foster Youth and those experiencing unstable housing (McKinney-Vento)
- August 14-18, 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
- Focus on ELA, Math and SEL as well as engaging students in a way that excites them to return to school the next week
- Transportation provided
- Taught by CVUSD teachers with the support of bilingual and special education paraeducators
