Combination Classes (concurrent teaching) - As of January 5, 2021

- As the Master Schedules were developed, the three comprehensive high schools were able to reduce the number of Combination classes by 41%.
- Combo class reduction from **Term 1 to Term 2** at all three high schools reduced from 811 sections to 474 sections.
- High Schools report that requests to move from Blended to Remote continue to come in. Accommodating all of these requests will require additional combination classes.

High School Athletics


As of Monday December 14, 2020, sites rolled back to Phase I in anticipation of the holidays and winter break.
