Enriched Learning Opportunities for All Students

- Teachers extend student learning through exploration of topics that lead to conversation, collaboration, critical thinking skills and investigations.
- Teachers incorporate the use of academic language and integrated instruction through project based learning.
- Science and Social Studies are introduced to students through non-fiction texts, investigations, simulations, and field trips.
- Teachers commit to designing instruction that includes personalized learning through small group instruction.
- Our staff implements positive behavior intervention supports through the use of CHAMPS.
- Our campus supervisors work together to provide an exceptional positive playground environment for all students.
- This year our school will launch a state of the art MakerSpace incorporating technology exploration, fashion design, and Media Arts where both students and teachers can incorporate these tools to extend and challenge students' everyday learning.
