The Conejo Valley Unified School District (CVUSD) realizes its responsibility in allowing choice to educators, parents and students in the selection and use of instructional materials. Choice for educators to develop the most effective collection of materials, and the choice of parents and students to seek an alternative grade 9-12 core literature assignment when personal sensibilities and/or values are in conflict with the assigned core literature titles. When content of core literature titles conflict with parent or student personal sensibilities and/or values, an alternative core literature assignment shall be provided upon parents following the proper protocols. The core literature alternative assignment protocols are delineated on the Curriculum page of the CVUSD website. Parents are strongly encouraged to review the assigned core literature selections. Teachers will review course requirements and core literature selections at the beginning of the school year.
