Need for maker space (stand Alone)

## Spatial Deficiencies:

Need for stage in MPR

- No Plumbing in portable buildings
- Poor condition of interior finishes


## Maintenance \& Accessibility Issues:

- Mechanical Systems need replacement

Drainage and ponding issues next to MPR
Replacement of non-matching window glazing
Other misc. ADA items (Door thresholds, Drinking Fountains, Sink height, Ramp Slope Handrails...etc)
